- There will be a \$175 premium fee per lot for the futurity.
- Any member of BBU is eligible to nominate cattle for this sale, provided they are a member or becomes a member of the STBBA or LOBBA. (\$30.00)

DEADLINE TO ENTER: November 28, 2018

STBBA & LOBBA reserves the right to change the total number of lots a seller may consign or change the number of cattle within categories to achieve a total of 80 lots. If a consignor wishes to consign more cattle, the Sale Manager will consider it after the nomination deadline has passed. **Nomination Deadline: November 28, 2018.**

Consignment must consist of the following:

- Completed and signed consignment form.
- **Nomination Fees - \$175 per lot NON-REFUNDABLE**
- This fee must accompany all consignments – No exceptions.
- Original Breeding Certificates
- All Consignments must be pre-screened by Sale Managers or Representative at a cost of \$100 per ranch.
- Footnotes are optional, but recommended.

Health Papers - **Cattle must be listed on the health certificate with the animal's permanent ID#(Traceability Requirements).** If you have any questions, check with your vet or go to www.tahc.state.tx.us.

Semen test and scrotal circumference on bulls and palpation on females must be shown on the health certificate. Testing must be done within 30 days of sale date. Bulls 18 months of age and older must pass a Breeding Soundness Evaluation (BSE). **The BSE can be filled out by a licensed Vet on the form provided by BBU or on the form issued by the Society of Theriogenology.**

1. Texas does recognize TB Free States and Brucellosis. You do not have to TB test, unless you are from an area that requires it.
2. All bulls must be Trich tested, Fertility tested, scrotal circumference and **BSE** test as stipulated above.

3. Palpation on each female.
 4. If you are coming from out of state, check with your vet for any special requirements.
- **Herd Bulls & Herd Bull Prospects (12), Maximum age 48 months.** All bulls will be judged in 1 category. Remember once bulls reach 30 months of age and older, they become harder to sell. This is a Futurity, not a good place to sell your older bulls of mediocre quality.
 - **3-N-1's & Pairs (25-30), Maximum age 96 months(8 Years)** Any female with a calf at side that is over 6 months of age must be palpated safe in calf.
 - **Bred Heifers (25-30), Age limit is 15 months to 36 months** Any heifer over 24 months of age must be palpated safe in calf.
 - **Open Heifers (20) Age limit up to 24 months of age.**
 - **Note: Picks will be accepted, however, STBBA & LOBBA is requiring that only cattle at least ½ blood related be accepted as picks. They must be out of the same sire or dam.**
 - **Special Lots: Donors, Flushes, Embryos, etc. will be accepted. If they do not qualify in a futurity, the Sale Manager will determine where they sell in the sale order.**

DISPLAY PENS: A limited number of display pens will be available for \$500 each. Consignors will have the option of penning their display cattle next to their sale cattle. Consignors may have the option of selling one of the display head in the case of multiple animals in display. For more information, contact Anthony Mihalski.

FUTURITY: There will be 4 classes of animals: Opens, Breds, Pairs/3n1's, and Bulls. Prize money will consist of \$1,000 to class winners, \$500 to reserves and a Grand Champion of the female classes will receive an extra \$1,000 and the Reserve Grand Champion will receive \$500.

The SELLER of each class winner will receive a commemorative belt buckle to signify their contribution to the sale. There will also be an award to the consignors of multiple lots for an all-around high point ranch award (recognition only), with a nice trophy and picture in the thank you ad following the sale.

STBBA & LOBBA reserve the right to change these classes depending on total numbers consigned in each class.

IMPORTANT: Nomination Deadline is November 28, 2018. If we do not receive 80 lots by this date, we reserve the right to allow consignors to consign additional cattle until we have reached 80 lots.

There will be a dinner on Friday evening for International guests and consignors to include drinks and dinner.
