**LOBBA Spring Sale Guidelines**

A total of 70 lots will be accepted for the sale. Categories will be limited to the **best seedstock cattle**. Categories will include **bulls, three-in-ones and pairs, bred/exposed and open heifers and bred cows**.

**AGAIN This SPRING SALE: PEN SALE** – accepting Open and Bred Heifers.

**Consignors must be willing to consign pens(groups) of 2 or 3 head. Heifers are not required to be related, but will be judged and sold in pens based on uniformity and quality. We recommend U2 quality or better.**

**A Premium/Nomination Fee per lot \$50 – Non-Refundable. (\$50 – Prize Money/ Awards/Expenses for Grading).**

Any member of BBU is eligible to nominate cattle for this sale, provided they are a LOBBA member or become a member of the LOBBA (\$30).

**Deadline to Enter: January 7, 2019**

**Premium/Nomination Fees – \$50 per lot (Non-Refundable)**

**This fee must accompany all consignments - No Exceptions**

Breeding Certificates (Original)

(Optional) Fee for Ranch Visit to inspect and select cattle for the sale is available at

\$100 per ranch visit. This information must be received in my office before inspections will be scheduled. Footnotes are optional and we recommend them.

**Health Papers** – Brucellosis and TB Tests are not required, however, the cattle must be listed on a health certificate with ID#'s and palpation.. Semen test and scrotal circumference on bulls and palpation on females must be shown on the health certificate. Testing must be done within 30 days of sale date. Bulls 18 months of age and older must pass a Breeding Soundness Evaluation (BSE). **The BSE can be filled out by a licensed Vet on the form provided by BBU or on the form issued by the Society of Theriogenology.**  
**Health Information:** A separate health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian is required on each lot consigned with all required information appearing thereon:

1. Texas does recognize TB Free States and Brucellosis. You do not have to TB test, unless you are from an area that requires it. Cattle must meet Traceability Requirements and be listed on the current health paper.
2. All bulls must be Trich tested, Fertility tested, scrotal circumference and **BSE** test as stipulated above.
3. Palpation on each female.
4. Have your vet check all eligible females to be sure they are Calhoun Vaccinated. If the females you have consigned are Calhoun Vaccinated for Brucellosis, this information must be stated on your health papers. **Testing must be done within 30 days of Sale Date.** Health certificates must accompany all cattle upon delivery at the sale site.

This sale is open to bulls, 3n1's, pairs, bred, and open heifers. The following rules apply to each category.

**Herd Bulls & Herd Bull Prospects** – The age requirement is 18 months to a maximum of 36 months. We do reserve the right to accept older bulls, but only well proven bulls with pedigree and reputation. This would be very limited and determined by the sale manager.

**3-N-1's and Pairs** – Maximum age requirement 96 months (8 years). Any female with a calf at side that is over 6 months of age must be palpated safe in calf.

**Bred Cows** – Age requirement is 36 months to 72 months of age - Only the highest quality will be accepted. Must be heavy bred to have a fall calf and should have production records to prove fertility.

**Bred and Exposed Heifers** – Age limit is 15 months to 36 months. Any heifer over 24 months of age must be palpated safe in calf according to BBU's Terms and Conditions.

**Open Heifers** – Age limit up to 24 months of age.

**PEN SALE** – accepting Open and Bred Heifers. **Consignors must be willing to consign pens(groups) of 2 or 3 head. Heifers are not required to be related, but will be judged and sold in pens based on uniformity and quality. We recommend U2 quality or better.**

Consignors are responsible for making sure their consignments have correct ID's and have correct permanent ID's on their consignments. Brands on all animals must be clipped to permit proper identification by BBU and Sale Management personnel. Any animal not meeting all the above listed requirements or any animal not of outstanding quality and in acceptable sale condition will be sifted and not allowed to sell.

**IMPORTANT: Nomination Deadline is January 7, 2019.**
