LBBA Rose Capitol Classic Guidelines

- A total of 80 lots will be accepted for the Rose Capitol Classic Graded Beefmaster Sale.
- Categories will include Bulls, Three in Ones and Pairs, Bred/Exposed & Open Heifers and Bred Cows.
- If more than 10 bulls are consigned, only the top 10 graded bulls will sell.
- Any member of BBU is eligible to nominate cattle for this sale, provided they are a member or becomes a member of the LBBA. (\$30.00)

Nomination Deadline: February 4, 2019 – Nomination Fee \$75 (\$50 Refundable - \$25 Grading Fee)

Consignment must consist of :

- Completed and signed consignment form
- Original Breeding Certificates and footnotes
- Nomination Fee \$50 per lot (Refundable if the animal sells through the sale.)
- Premium Fee \$25 – Non-Refundable for prize money and awards.

Health Papers:

A separate health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian is required on each lot consigned with all required information appearing thereon:

- You must meet requirements for Brucellosis, TB and Trichomoniasis(Trich) on each animal old enough to require testing. Louisiana is a Brucellosis and TB free state, no testing is required but you must have health papers.
- All bulls 12 months and older must be Trich Tested.
- Fertility test, scrotal circumference and **BSE** test as stipulated above.
- Palpation on each female.
- All cattle must meet Traceability Requirements.
- Have your vet check all eligible females to be sure they are Calfhood Vaccinated. If the females you have consigned are Calfhood Vaccinated for Brucellosis, this information must be stated on your health papers.

Testing must be done within 30 days of Sale Date. Health certificates must meet the standard of both state and federal requirements and must accompany all cattle upon delivery at the sale site.

Bulls – are limited to sell only the top 10. 18 to 48 months of age maximum. We recommend trying to stay under 36 months of age – Older bulls are harder to sell. If we have over 10 bulls consigned only the top 10 graded bulls will sell. One bull per consignor. If we do not reach 10 bulls by nomination deadline, call Sales Manager to add a second bull.

*****New requirement on bull consignment – Paint or white bulls will not be accepted.***

Three-In-Ones or Pairs – Age limit 96 months of age (8 years). Any female with a calf at side that is six months of age or older, must be palpated safe in calf by a licensed vet and this information must appear on the health paper.

Bred Heifers – Up to 36 months of age. Any heifer over 24 months of age must be palpated safe in calf by a licensed vet and this information must appear on the health paper.

Bred Cows – Age limit 96 months. Only the highest quality will be accepted and should be heavy bred to have a fall calf. If possible, production records to prove fertility could be used for footnotes.

Open Heifers/Show Prospects – Weaned to 24 months of age. These heifers will be guaranteed open and certified by a licensed vet and so stated on the health paper.

This will be an all graded sale. The sale offering will be graded Friday afternoon by a panel judges and will sell in graded order on Saturday.

Catalog information – Footnotes for the catalog are optional; however, we urge you to send any pertinent data you have on each animal, especially weights and measures information and calving records.

Every animal must be of excellent quality and in excellent condition. The LBBA Board and the Sale Manager recommend that all cattle consigned be of 2-2 quality or better.

The sale order will be based on the grading, so consign your best!
